Record Setters

**Two records fall at Gehringer vs. Benicia-- The first record to fall was the Girls 11-12 100 yard Individual Medley. The previous record of 1:11.80 stood for 21 years after being set by Dina Carramusa of the Gators on June 22, 1983. Ashley Jennings broke it with a sizzling 1:10.82.

The next record to fall was the 15-18 Women's Freestyle Relay. The old record of 1:54.60 had been set by Erin Cullenwood, Desiraea Ferriera, Rachel Hansen, and Leah Sonnenberg of Springwood on June 29, 2002. The new pool record of 1:54.37 was set by Jacqueline Elliot, Kayla Hall, Kayla Scardaci and Kelly McCabe.

**Erik Carlson, Valley Vista, breaks a 20-year-old 9/10 Freestyle pool record and Jamie Krochka set a new team record in the 11/12 Freestyle AND broke her own pool record in the 11/12 Butterfly at the Ygnacio Woods A meet!

**Gerald Gee set a Skimmer team record in the 13/14 Boys 50 Backstroke with a time of 28.39. The old record set by John Hendrickson in 1977, was 28.90. Gerald also broke the home pool record also set by Hendrickson in 1977-- 29.60. The record was broken in the Brentwood "A" meet held at ADS's home pool.
