Forest Park vs. Ygnacio Wood

Sitting at it's first 3-2 season in over 5 years, Forest Park had one more large hurdle to climb to reach third place in the A division: Ygnacio Wood.

It had been at least ten years since FP had beaten YW in a dual meet; this time the Flyers were ready. In a close meet throughout, FP won eight of the free relays to squeak out a 411-399 victory! Hayden Bailey (9-10) and 11-12 Katie O'Connor turned in outstanding anchor swims in the free relays to steal victories for their age groups.

In the final relays, FP's 15-18 girls' squad of Dana Whitehead, Megan Ring, Elise Denes and Kelly Pearce broke the pool record with a time of 1:47.68. Two lanes over, FP's 15-18 boys' relay of Sebastian Vanhoven, Kyle Villareal, Glen Carino and Marco Brunamonti broke a six-year-old 400 free relay pool record with a time of 3:32. Kelly Pearce also broke the pool record in I.M. with a time of 1:05.1.

With so many close races, the competition at League meet is sure to be tight.

Saturday, July 17, 2004 and Sunday July 18, 2004

Round Hill - W - 902 San Ramon - 725

The Blackhawk Swim Team scored 898-768 in a home victory over the **Crow Canyon Sea Lions** to capture the Valley Swim Association's meet championship on July 17 at the Blackhawk Pool. It was a very competitive meet, as both teams started the day with visions of capturing the 2004 meet championship. The HOX had too much depth on the day, breaking an early tie and eventually pulling away for the victory. The Crow Canyon Sea Lions, fresh off their first place finish at the Aqua Pentathlon, showed they will be a force to be reckoned with at the league and county championships. Although they came up short in their quest to capture the meet championship, the Sea Lions left the Blackhawk Pool with five new pool records! Dillon Williams had an outstanding day, setting pool records in the 7-8 Boys I.M. (1:22.8), Backstroke (17.67), and Butterfly (16.01). Colin Chiapello set a pool record in the 7-8 Boys Breaststroke (18.74), while Chris Glass set a new pool record in the Boys 15-18 Backstroke (1:00.56). Both teams look strong heading into the League Championship meet, scheduled for July 31 at the California High School pool, and are eager to continue the healthy rivalry that has developed in recent seasons.

Forest Park Flyers and Antioch Delta Skimmers Break Records(Posted July 2, 2004)

At the Forest Park vs. Antioch swim meet on June 30, ADS's Gerald Gee broke the pool record for 13-14 boys' fly with a time of 26.72. The previous record holder, with a time of 27.40, was FP's Glen Carino (2002). Gerald also broke the 13-14 boys' back record with a new time of 28.08. The previous record was a 28.31 swum by FP's Shane Hudlin in 2000.

Also, FP's Kelly Pearce broke the pool record in the 15-18 girls' 100 Backstroke with a time of 1:09.18. The old record was 1:09.37 set in 1998 by Elizabeth Knight of Bishop Estates.

At the Battle of the Ages in Pleasant Hill last weekend, Kelly Pearce broke the Forest Park team record in the girls' 100 Freestyle with the time of 56.14. This shattered the 10-year-old mark previously held by Amanda Gillespie. Also at Battle of the Ages, FP's Glen Carino toppled the 100 Breastroke record for 16-year-old boys division.

At the Valley Vista vs. Forest Park meet on June 23, Glen Carino, swimming in lane one, broke the 15-18 boy's 100 Breastroke pool record, which was previously held by former teammate Johnny Gillespie. Also, Karl Guldner from Forest Park broke the Valley Vista 13-14 boy's 50 Breast pool record (This was Karl's first swim record; but it will not be his last.). Also at the meet, Kelly Pearce smashed the FP team record in the 15-18 girl's 100 I.M. with a time of 1:05.04, breaking a 26-year-old record held by Sue Satmary.
