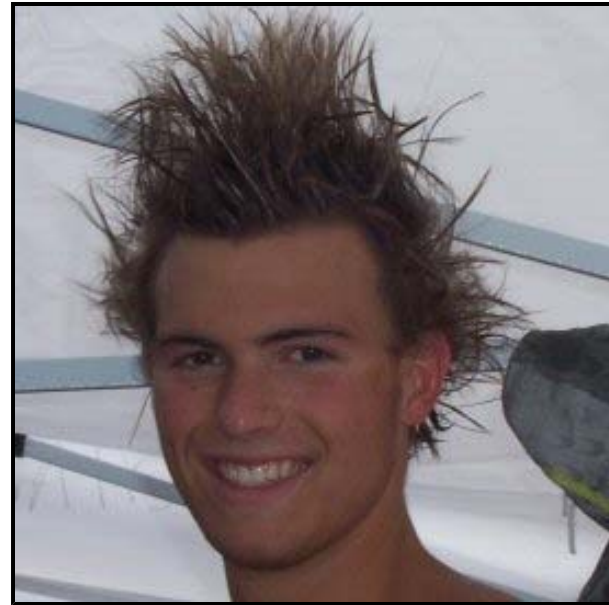

Larkey Sharks' **Bryan Snyder** (11/12) (left); Head Coach, **Sarah Stretch** and **Jake Simpson** (7/8) at the Walnut Creek Swim Conference Championships where both boys won high point. (SPECIAL NOTE: A little trivia-- Bryan, at age 11 at the Walnut Creek City Meet in 2005, broke (Terrapins co-founder & National Team Coach) **Ray Mitchell's** 50 yd. backstroke record of 31.30 set in 1970 with his new record of 31.21 only to break his own record in a 30.34 at Walnut Creek Swim Conference Championships!) Bryan (12) broke his own backstroke record at Conference again with a 29.20, then broke it again at County with a 28.49! He broke his own I.M. record at Conference again in a 1:04.66. Additionally, Bryan broke the freestyle record held by Ian Todd of 25.58 at Conference with a 25.23 and won High Point for the 3rd year in a row! Teammate **Jake Simpson** (8) broke a couple Larkey Sharks records, too: Breaststroke- old record was 19.57. He swam it in a new record time of 19.10. The old I.M. record of 1:27.15 was put to rest by Jake's new smashing record of 1:25.24!

*These four Springbrook girls swam across Acalanes High School pool in fiery fashion at Walnut Creek Swim Conference Championships Sunday, Aug. 13, setting a new record in the 11-12 girls 200 yard free relay in a 1:50.19. The old record, 1:50.54, was set in 1996 by DVRA. They are: **Natalie Chan** (12), **Chelsea Chenault** (11), **Bryce Tanner** (12) and **Brooke Aiello** (11) (NOTE: Chelsea also broke the 2005 I.M. record of 1:08.24 set by Christy Tormey, setting a new record of 1:07.9.)*



*What a sweet, sincere smile -- Rudgear Estates' swimmer, **Natalie Smith** (14), swam butterfly in a new record time of 26.71, breaking her own 2005 record of 27.42 and additionally broke Shannon Pegnim's 2005 50 yard freestyle record of 24.95 in a 24.72 at Walnut Creek Swim Conference Championships Sunday, Aug. 13. When we asked what the secret to her success was, she said, "Stretch and focus and great, supportive coaches. Work hard for your goals, and dreams can come true!"*



Ygnacio Wood coaches not only won the 100 yard freestyle relay at Concord City Meet, Aug. 6, but did it in a record-breaking time of 42.57--.44 seconds off the old record!
