Six Crow Canyon Sharks swimmers have signed letters of intent to swim and row in college.

The swimmers and their colleges are Olivia Alva (Washington State University), Paige Bradley (University of Minnesota), Bridget Bugbee (UC Davis), Keri George (San Diego State University), Kara Kohler (to row at the UC Berkeley) and Ocean Trail (UC Irvine).
